#### Dear Geoff:

SCS Engineers, on behalf of the Cass County Environmental Control Agency (Agency), is providing an update related to the Cass County Sanitary Landfill (Landfill) Permit No. 15-SDP-01-75P. The operational permit for the Landfill expires on December 5, 2023. The Landfill stopped taking waste on June 30, 2022 and has communicated with the lowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) the process through which it was working through closure. Closure construction was completed in November 2023. The Construction Observation Report is anticipated to be submitted to the DNR by December 15, 2023. Upon DNR review and acceptance, the Closure Permit for the Landfill should be issued.

In the meantime, we are providing Permit Application Form 50 (attached) to maintain the Landfill permit. Note that Section 2 of Form 50 was not completed as the Landfill is all but administratively closed. It is our understanding that the DNR will be requiring an environmental covenant (EC) rather than the deed notation related to the closed landfill. Once the EC information has been finalized by the DNR, the Agency will take necessary steps to complete the process in a timely manner.
