The Waste Commission of Scott County in 2023 shipped 234 pounds of refrigerant. As of December 31, 2023, 10 pounds is ready for shipment.

The Waste Commission of Scott County does not send any sodium chromate units to another to demanufacture. We currently have 11 units in inventory awaiting demanufacture. No chromate units demanufactured at this time.

A 5-gallon UN rated bucket to store mercury containing components will be open when a mercury component is removed from an appliance.

In accordance with Iowa Administrative Code 567 Chapter 118.13(1) – Annual reports with the information required in subrule 118.13(2) are due January 31 each year for the activities of the previous calendar year shall be retained at the facility for at least three years.
