Based on the rationale noted in your request below, the DNR is hereby granting the requested 30-day extension to provide Faircast, Inc. and SCS Engineers with additional time to complete the required reporting.

At this time, the DNR intends to exercise its enforcement discretion on this matter and not pursue enforcement of Special Provision 6(h) of the closure permit (Doc #103126) provided the AWQR for 2023 is received by the DNR on or before April 1, 2024.
