As we prepare for the landfill closure work, I wanted to provide an update and revisit the payment requirements established in the IDNR Trust (attached for reference). First, we have a signed agreement with a contractor to perform the dirt work and expect them to begin in the next few weeks. Do we need the official closure permit in hand to begin or are we ok to start with the work? Secondly, there will be a few different vendors/contractors completing all the closure work including, fence removal and reinstallation, dirt work, surveying, seeding, etc. Per section 4 of the Trust (provided below), invoices for work to be paid from the Trust shall be sent to IDNR for review/approval. Who at IDNR should these invoices be sent for review and approval?
