Re: Permit #07-ADP-11-20

Dear Mr. Adams:

The field office conducted an inspection at your appliance demanufacturing facility on August 7, 2024. The inspection letter dated August 20, 2024 stated that you have closed the facility at 512 Almond Street and have relocated to 17 Lafayette Street, Waterloo, and requires some information to be updated for a permit to demanufacture appliances. Since that inspection, the DNR has received no updated information from you.

Before a permit can be issued for the new location, you will need to update the following:

- Complete the appliance demanufacturing form located on the DNRs [website](#), with the new location information and proof of ownership or rental agreement and flood plain information as stated on the form.
- Updated financial assurance mechanism. The former cost closure estimate can be used, which allows up to 65 appliances on site. If you will have more than that on site, you will need to have your cost closure estimate adjusted by an Engineer, certified in Iowa. Your current cost closure estimate is for \$1,787.00. Have your lending institution contact me via email, and I can send them the proper form.
- Obtain a new PCB ID number for the new location, and let them know to remove the PCB ID number from the older location. The form ([available here](#)) should be updated to your new location and can be emailed to [ORCRPCBs@epa.gov](mailto:ORCRPCBs@epa.gov). Make sure you provide them with your former address so they can removed that PCB ID number in your name, or you could still be liable for any future spills at the former location. EPA will reply to you with an ID number, I will need that for your permit.

All the other permit information can be transferred, such as operations plan etc. When all the required documents are submitted, a permit to demanufacture appliances can be issued for the Lafayette location. If you do not wish to demanufacture appliances any longer, please let me know so you can be removed from our list.

The former permit (Permit #07-ADP-11-20) is being rescinded, so there is no current permit for Adams Recycling.
