The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed the 2024 Annual Water Quality Report (AWQR), dated February 19, 2025, as submitted on your behalf by SCS Engineers. The DNR has the following comments:

### **Report Priority**

None.

#### **Sampling Summary**

Monitoring at the site includes:

- 1. Background monitoring points: MWPZ-8A, MWPZ-8B-2, MW-22A, and MW-27.
- 2. Downgradient monitoring points: MW-22B, MW-23, MW-25, MW-19, MWPZ-16A, MW-12, MW-18, MW-26, MW-20, and MW-28.
- 3. Wells that are currently in assessment monitoring: MW-PZ-16A, MW-19, MW-18, MW-20, MW-25, and MW-23.
- 4. Monitoring wells currently in corrective action: MW-22B and MW-28.
- 5. The DNR concurs with the recommendations in "Section 6.0" of the report.

#### **Monitoring Well Maintenance and Performance Reevaluation**

The monitoring well maintenance plan is present and future maintenance is planned out. The DNR has no further comments.

# **Leachate Control System Performance Evaluation Report**

The landfill has been closed since 2008, areas with leachate collection lines are regularly inspected and cleaned. The DNR acknowledges the head levels above 12 inches, with no noticeable trends increasing nor decreasing. The DNR has no further comments.

## **Gas Monitoring Report**

The measured explosive gas concentrations did not exceed 100% of the lower explosive limit (LEL). The DNR has no further comments.
