Permit number 57-SDP-03-75C issued on September 21, 2006, for the Closed Cedar Rapids/Linn County Solid Waste Agency Sanitary Landfill #1 is hereby amended by the following:

• A new special provision is added as follows:

The permit holder shall implement the Corrective Action Changes - Elevation Monitoring Plan (Doc No. 112240), as submitted by Foth on March 3, 2025, and report the results in the 2025 Annual Water Quality Report (AWQR). If the schedule for the switchover of the horizontal collector well does not allow for a minimum of 6 months of data collection and evaluation before preparation of the AWQR, then the permit holder shall submit a separate report and evaluation within 60 days of the completion of data collection.
