Good afternoon. We have reviewed the above-referenced report. Based on observed conditions, it was recommended that the rip rap protection over a prior seep be expanded due to damage to the cap from wildlife. As you are aware, to move toward reducing or terminating post-closure care, the cap vegetation needs to be maintained and leachate seeps controlled. Please provide an action plan on or before June 20, 2025, including a schedule, for addressing the noted cap damage. An email response is sufficient.
