Mike -

During the Spring 2025 statistical evaluation, exceedances of prediction limits or single DQR detections were observed for barium, cobalt, copper, lead, 2-butanone, and acetone in MW-33A, and for cadmium and zinc in MW-44A. At the time, AECOM recommended resampling in August 2025.

Since then, Foth has assumed the role of environmental consultant for Winneshiek County. Given that both wells are currently in assessment/corrective action monitoring, we do not recommend resampling. Instead, we intend to declare these parameters as statistically significant increases (SSIs).
