Comments: This facility contains three recycling bays and seven solid waste bays. Waste is loaded directly into transport vehicles located below the loading bays. During the winter months, one load of waste is hauled to the L.P Gill Landfill. During the remainder of the year, up to five loads per day are hauled to the landfill. The west bay overhead doors are now remaining closed due to wind-blown litter issues. Only the east bay overhead doors are utilized.
