Additional Comments:

The Waste Commission of Scott County in 2025 shipped 162 pounds of refrigerant. As of December 31, 2025, 178 pounds is ready for shipment.

The Waste Commission of Scott County sends any sodium chromate units to Weikert Recycling to demanufacture. We currently have 2 units in inventory awaiting shipment to demanufacture.

A 5-gallon UN rated bucket to store mercury containing components will be open when a mercury component is removed from an appliance.

In accordance with Iowa Administrative Code 567 Chapter 118.13(1) - Annual reports with the information required in subrule 118.13(2) are due January 31 each year for the activities of the previous calendar year shall be retained at the facility for at least three years.

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
