The Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has reviewed our records regarding the above-referenced CRT Collection Registration and confirmed that Marshall County Landfill CRT has failed to submit an Annual Activity Report ([DNR Form 542-8131](#)) as required by [rule 567-122.11\(455D\)](#). This report is due to the DNR by February 1st of each year for the previous calendar year to fulfill the annual registration renewal requirement for the following year.

Following a courtesy notice issued to all registered CRT Collection facilities in December 2025, the failure to submit this report has resulted in the expiration of your CRT Collection Registration effective March 1, 2026.

Marshall County Landfill CRT must immediately cease all CRT collection activities at this location and properly manage any remaining discarded CRTs onsite. The DNR has removed this registration from our list of active projects and has closed this project file. No further action is required at this time.

If Marshall County Landfill CRT wishes to resume CRT collection activities at this location, please submit a new CRT Collection Registration Form ([DNR Form 542-0060](#)) to the DNR.
