Good afternoon Brad-

The closure permit for the Louisa County Sanitary Landfill was issued on October 21, 1994 (Doc #13798). The expiration date was extended by five years to October 21, 2029, in correspondence dated September 16, 2024 (Doc #110877).

Special Provision X.5.g. of the closure permit was amended in Permit Amendment #4, issued August 11, 2003 (Doc #52948):

g. An Annual Water Quality Report (AWQR) summarizing the effects the facility is having on groundwater and surface water quality shall be submitted to the Department's Main and local Field offices by November 30 each year. This report shall be prepared in accordance with 567 IAC 113.26(8)"d" by a Professional Engineer licensed in the State of Iowa. The AWQR shall include the results of the semiannual groundwater measurements and the routine groundwater analyses conducted at the monitoring points. By means of a

variance granted on August 8, 2003, groundwater measurements are required to be taken in April and October of each year.

It is requested that the permit be modified so that "Professional Engineer licensed in the State of Iowa" be changed to "qualified groundwater scientist" as defined in 567 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 113.10(1)d."

In addition, it is requested that the frequency of water level measurements be reduced from semi-annual to when groundwater samples are collected.

The recommended language for the amended Special Provision X.5.g is as follows:

g. An Annual Water Quality Report (AWQR) summarizing the effects the facility is having on groundwater and surface water quality shall be submitted to the Department's Main and local Field offices by November 30 each year. This report shall be prepared in accordance with 567 IAC 113.26(8)"d" by a qualified groundwater scientist as defined in 113.10(1)d. The AWQR shall include the results of the groundwater measurements and the routine groundwater analyses conducted at the monitoring points.
