On October 30, 1996, I visited the sites known as: Erenberger 77, Kula 150, Dniederhauser 155, Fneiderhauser 157, Blahnik, Robinson 80, Buresh Home, Cozzie 99, Hoverka 40, Dneiderhauser 120, Dneiderhauser 102, Gneiderhauser 79, Langhurst 160, Ulch 108, Davidson 160, Tenno 197, and Kula Fairview Farm. Those are the sites where Environmental Land Management has land applied biomass since my last inspection. The biomass is generated by Genencor International, Inc., Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
