Dear Ms. Bogaert:

On September 13, 2010, Jim Kacer (DNR staff) and I conducted a compliance inspection of Lafarge's Closed CKD Landfill. During the course of the inspection, we observed and asked Lafarge to fix the following:

1. removal of deep rooted vegetation on the surface of the closed cell and
2. installing protective barriers around the groundwater monitoring wells

On November 30, 2010, I observed that brightly colored flats were installed on top of the ground water monitoring wells and you indicated that the sapling trees were cut from the surface of the landfill. You also indicated that in the spring of 2011, a brush killer chemical will be applied to prohibit future growth. On December 2, 2010, I received an email from you indicating that Terracon was onsite installing the protective concrete barriers around the monitoring wells (the wells that are located in areas susceptible to being impacted by heavy machinery, snow plows etc).

Therefore, this matter is considered to be closed at this time. I will stop by the facility later this month to snap a couple of photos for our file to document the above mentioned items.
