To whom it may concern:

Landfarm permit # 00-SDP-03-06P-PCS expired on June 20, 2012. Effective immediately, Anderson Excavating, Inc. is no longer authorized to landfarm petroleum contaminated soils (PCS) under the above referenced permit. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) shall remove your name from the current list of permitted Single-Use Landfarms. If you decide to commence Landfarming of PCS, a completed permit application form 542-8126 with supporting documentation must be submitted to the DNR for prior approval.

In accordance with IAC 567-120.12(2) (455B,455D), the landfarm site(s) referenced in permit # 00-SDP-03-06P-PCS will be considered closed after three years following the last land application of petroleum contaminated soils, which was on December 1, 2008. Therefore, Anderson Excavating, Inc. is no longer required to maintain financial assurance for this project after December 1, 2011 and is hereby released of their financial assurance obligations on that date.
