Dear Mr. Hanson:

This correspondence shall serve as official notice of voluntary rescission of Alliant Energy's Beneficial Use Determination (BUD), issued on December 24, 2018 (Doc #94041). This rescission is in response to your February 25, 2021 request (Doc #99852), which states that Interstate Power and Light Company will no longer utilize these materials from the Ottumwa, Burlington and Prairie Creek Generating Stations as a soil stabilizer in cattle feed lots and for storage pad construction (e.g., composting pads, machinery and commodity storage).

Per this request and effective immediately, the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) will remove the above-referenced BUD from our list of active projects and will close this project file. Therefore, no further action is necessary and all other activities associated with the BUD are no longer required. Please note that pursuant to Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 567 Chapter 108.7(2), records related to the solid by-product management plan for this determination shall be kept on file for five (5) years.

Rescission of the BUD in no way relieves Interstate Power and Light Company of the responsibility of complying with other DNR permitting requirements and all other local, state and federal statutes or rules that are applicable to activities conducted at or by these facilities. If in the future Interstate Power and Light Company decides to undertake other beneficial reuse activities and desires coverage under 567 IAC 108, a completed BUD application with supporting documentation shall be submitted to the DNR.
