The storm water discharge will be from water main replacement located in the NW 1/4 of Section 4, SE, NE, NW 1/4 of Section 5, NE & NW 1/4 of Section 6 in Township 70N Range 03W; all of Section 31, SE, NE, NW 1/4 of Section 32; SW of Section 33 in Township Range 03W in Des Moines County. Storm water will be discharged from 2 point sources and will be discharged to Brush Creek to Skunk Slough to the Mississippi River and Spring Creek to Mississippi River.


