Ryan Companies US, Inc. plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Construction Activities." The storm water discharge will be from grading operations and construction of a museum, commercial and hotel development, which is part of the Techworks Addition located in Waterloo, Iowa, in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) and the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) of Section 23-T89N-R13W and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) and the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) of Section 26-T89N-R13W, both sections are in the 5th P.M. in Black Hawk, Iowa. Storm water will be discharged from three point sources and will be discharged into the Cedar River.
