

PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

DeLong Construction, Inc. plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities." The storm water discharge will be from sections 7 and 18 of township 69N, range 3W in Middletown, Iowa. Storm water will be discharged from 2 point sources and will be discharged from natural drainage ditches on the property to Long Creek, south to the Skunk River.
