

PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE
Cargill Incorporated plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities." The storm water discharge will be from site development activities located in the NW 1/4 - SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 73 North, Range 16 W, Monroe County, Iowa. Storm water will be discharged from 1 point source and will be discharged to Miller Creek, tributary to the Des Moines River. Comments may be submitted to the Storm Water Discharge Coordinator, IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, Environmental Protection Division, Henry A.
