## Public Notice of Storm Water Discharge

The Iowa Southern Railway (ISRY) plans to submit a "Notice of Intent" to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit #2, "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities".

The storm water discharge will be from construction activities at the ISRY Moravia Freight Transload Site. Soils disturbance will include the following: Installation of Perimeter erosion and sediment control practices and stabilized construction entrance, site clearing and grubbing, equipment removal, gravel removal, temporary and permanent grading and seeding. Other activities will include construction of a transloader's building, gravel road and parking, installation of sanitary, water, storm electrical and lighting facilities, along with final grading and site stabilization work needed to complete the project. The project is located adjacent to the ISRY railroad tracks in the northwestern part of Moravia, Iowa. The location is in the SE quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 4, T 70 N., R 17 W of Appanoose County, Iowa.

Storm water runoff from this site will surface drain from one (1) point source; runoff will discharge freely to an existing drainage swale that conveys the storm water to the City of Moravia's natural storm water drainage pattern which outlets to South Soap Creek which is a tributary to Sundown Lake. No significant increase in storm water runoff is anticipated as a result of this site modification.
