Public Notice of Storm Water Discharge

The City of Fairfield, Iowa plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Construction Activities". The storm water discharge will be from the construction of the Fairfield Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project, Bid Package No. 1 - Treatment Facility Improvements and Bid Package No. 2 - Flow Equalization Basin Improvements, located in SE quarter of Section 1, Township 71 North, Range 10 West and Section 6, Township 71 North, Range 9 West, Jefferson County. Storm water will be discharged from 1 point source(s) and will be discharged to the following streams: Crow Creek. Comments may be submitted to the Storm Water Discharge Coordinator, Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division, 502 E. 9th Street, Des Moines, IA 50319-0034. The public may review the Notice of Intent from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the above address after it has been received by the department.


