The storm water discharge will be from the expansion of an existing Industrial building and parking lot, located south-east of the intersection of Airport Blvd. and Midport Blvd. in Waterloo, Iowa, in the SW 1/4 of Section 4-T89N-R13W in Black Hawk County, Iowa. Storm water will be discharged into the ground and into City storm sewer to Noname Creek and to the Cedar River.
