PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

Koch Fertilizer Fort Dodge LLC plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities"

The storm water discharge will be from construction of a new MCC Building, construction of a new product tank, and excavation for fire water line construction located in NE 1/4, Section 27, Township 89 N, Range 27 W.

Storm water will be discharged from 2 point sources and will be discharged to the following streams: Brushy Creek and The Des Moines River.
