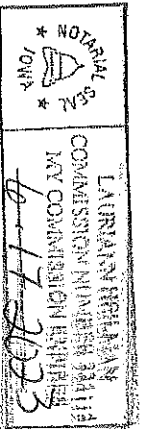

PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

Beck Excavating Inc. plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities."

The storm water discharge will be from Excavation, Site Grading, Utilities Installation, and Paving.

The project is located in the South East quarter of Section 4, Township 99 North, Range 36 West of the 5th P.M. Dickinson County, IA.

Storm water runoff from this work will overland flow to Storm Sewer System and East Okoboji Lake.
