Item is used again without being broken down and most likely the item is used for the same purpose.



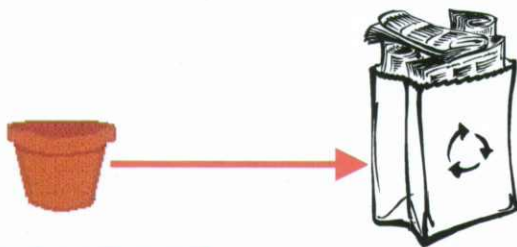
Why do we need to Recycle?

Saves Natural Resources



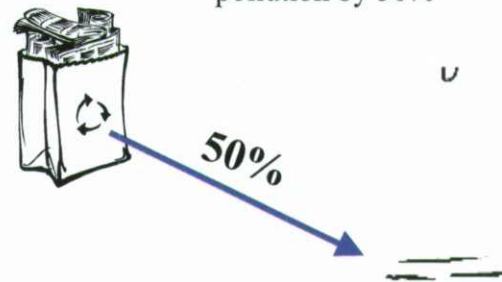
Why do we need to Recycle?

- It takes 17 trees to produce 1 ton of newspaper.



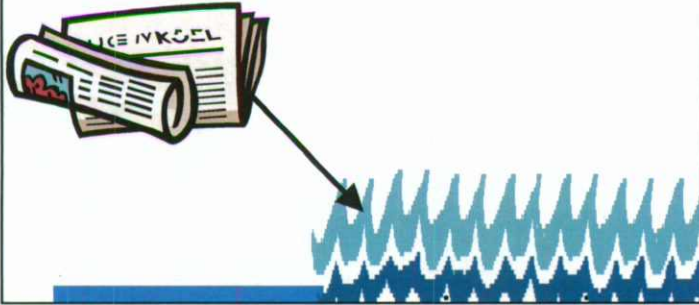
Why do we need to Recycle?

- Recycling newspaper reduces air and water pollution by 50%



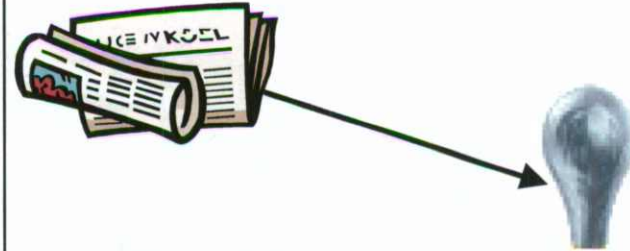
Why do we need to Recycle?

- Recycling 1 ton of newspaper saves 7000 gallons of water.



Why do we need to Recycle?

- Recycling 1 ton of newspaper saves 4100 kilowatts of electricity.
