On September 9, 2015, it was reported to us that soil sample result D6 exceeded the department's action level for benzene (0.592 mg/kg) and toluene (8.85 mg/kg). Samples were collected following the removal of UST system at the above referenced site. The department has not yet received the closure report, only the analytical report.

Based upon the sample results from D6, a preliminary LUST report was prepared and a LUST ID issued (9LTR07). The analytical report was forwarded to Lisa Niedermayer, who will be the project manager for LUST 9LTR07. Shortly, you will receive a Tier 1 letter requirement from Lisa.
